ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION, POWERS, AND DUTIES OF
A CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

WHEREAS, the City of Stanford has began the process of enacting new legislation as it relates to nuisances, and code enforcement, will have fully enacted said new ordinances, prior to the second reading of this ordinance, and said legislation requires a code enforcement officer also known as a citation officer to enforce it;

WHEREAS, KRS 83A.060 states the procedure for the amendment and/or enactment of ordinances of this nature;

WHEREAS, the City Council has deemed it appropriate and necessary to formally establish a Code Enforcement Board, with a Code Enforcement Officer, whose powers are vested in him under KRS 83A.087, and have them hear violations of the City of Stanford Parking Codes;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF STANFORD AS
FOLLOWS;

SECTION 37.07 CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

- (A) The Code Enforcement officer shall not have the powers of peace officers to make arrest or carry concealed deadly weapons. This section shall not be a limitation on the power of a citation officer to make an arrest as a private person as provided in KRS 431.005
- (B) The Code Enforcement Officer may issue citations as authorized by ordinance of nonmoving motor vehicle offenses, and violations of ordinances, including but not limited to those procedures described in Chapter 92 of the City of Stanford Code of Ordinances, commonly referred to as nuisances.
- (C) The Code Enforcement Officer shall under no circumstance cause to be issued a citation for any violation of the Kentucky Penal Code.
- (D) The Code Enforcement Officer shall under no circumstance cause to be issued a citation for any violation, which would have the adverse effect of punishing a victim of domestic violence.
- (E) The City Clerk shall at all times keep in it's possession for reference a copy of KRS 83A.087;
- (F) The Code Enforcement Officer has other duties as described in Stanford Code of Ordinances, Chapter 92 and 41; and
- (G) The Code Enforcement Officer shall issue violations in accordance with KRS 82.600-82.640.

This Ordinance shall take effect on this the _____ day of _____, 2017.

May, 2017 at the Council's regular meeting and for the second time and approved, on the 15th day of May, 2017 at a special meeting meeting.




