Purpose of public – Grant for new police cruiser through USDA

Mayor Carter asked Chief Zach Middleton to explain grant.

Chief Middleton informed those in attendance public hearing must be held for grant. Chief Middleton explained the grant is through USDA Law Enforcement. They pay 55% of the cost of Dodge Durango purchased from Glenn Freedom Dodge who has state contract for Dodge. The total cost is around \$32,000 fully equipped. The grant covers \$17783.00, city pays \$14550.00.

Chief Middleton informed those in attendance some of the vehicles police department has are getting old with a lot of wear and tear on them.

Rosemary Hazlett asked how many vehicles need to be replaced. Police Chief Middleton responded five.

Mayor Carter informed those in attendance last year we bought three late model cruisers from Danville and we may look at lease. Mayor added we bought one new one last year.

Mayor informed those in attendance next year he would look at lease program to see about getting another Durango.
